
Exhibition of award-winning works [From October 1] [Important] (WCSS World Championship Series)

The WLS World League Series (preliminary screening) for the WASA World Architecture Student Awards 2022 (international competition) was held on September 1st. The 100 works that have passed the preliminary screening are published on the official website of the competition. At the WCSS World Championship Series (second screening), architects, university teachers, and architecture students from all over the world will vote and ask questions to select the World Championship Medals. The world vote uses GoogleForm to make it easy to share values around the world. Thank you for your



■[Overview of qualifying screening]

In the preliminary screening, we conducted an objective screening based on the database by AIGA (AI genius architect-G1-Version14), analyzed the capabilities of the designers with high accuracy, and quantified the design capabilities. After scoring, we selected 100 designs from the 10 types of leagues that the designers are most good at.

All League-15 works...A league that competes for the completeness of the work, such as the content of the design proposal, the expression technique, the ability to think and create, and other special characteristics.

(1st place - Genius architect Medal) (2nd place - Master architect Medal) (3rd to 15th places - Best Selection Award)

One League-11 works...A league that competes for comprehensive ability only in proposal content such as thinking ability, creativity, and other special characteristics in design proposals.

 $(1st\ place\ -\ Genius\ production\ Medal)\ (2nd\ place\ -\ Master\ production\ Medal)\ (3rd\ to\ 15th\ places\ -\ Best\ Selection\ Award)$

Two League-11 works...A league that competes for comprehensive ability only in expression techniques such as thinking ability, creativity, and other special characteristics in design proposals.

(1st place - Genius presentation Medal) (2nd place - Master presentation Medal) (3rd to 15th place - Best Selection Award)

A League-9 works...A league that competes for the overall ability of concepts such as the background of the design proposal, response to society, contemporary, criticality, etc., and consistency of the entire work

 $(1st\ place\ -\ Genius\ solution\ Medal)\ (2nd\ place\ -\ Master\ solution\ Medal)\ (3rd\ to\ 15th\ place\ -\ Best\ Selection\ Award)$

B League-9 works...A league that competes for the overall ability of the historical, cultural and physical context of the site city and surroundings and the coherence of the whole work.

 $(1st\ place-Genius\ context\ Medal)\ (2nd\ place-Master\ context\ Medal)\ (3rd\ to\ 15th\ places-Best\ Selection\ Award)$

C League-9 works... A league that competes for the overall ability of the use and partial functions of the whole building, the business and management scheme, and the consistency of the whole work.

 $(1st\ place-Genius\ building\ Medal)\ (2nd\ place-Master\ building\ Medal)\ (3rd\ to\ 15th\ place-Best\ Selection\ Award)$

D League-9 works... A league that competes for comprehensive ability in the process of architectural forms such as design methods, molding methods, renewal methods, and consistency of the entire work.

(1st place - Genius maniera Medal) (2nd place - Master maniera Medal) (3rd to 15th place - Best Selection Award)

E League-9 Works...This is a league that competes for the overall ability of the proportions, the form of the constituent elements, the spatial composition, the structure, etc., and the consistency of the work as a whole

 $(1st\ place\ -\ Genius\ Form\ design\ Medal)\ (2nd\ place\ -\ Master\ Form\ design\ Medal)\ (3rd\ to\ 15th\ place\ -\ Best\ Selection\ Award)$

F League-9 works...A league that competes for overall ability of spatiality such as interior and exterior space, landscape, interior, materials, etc. and consistency of the whole work.

(1st place - Genius Space design Medal) (2nd place - Master Space design Medal) (3rd to 15th place - Best Selection Award)

G League-9 works... A league that competes for the overall ability of activity, community, sequence, spatial experience of the five senses, and coherence of the work as a whole.

(1st place - Genius Human design Medal) (2nd place - Master Human design Medal) (3rd to 15th place - Best Selection Award)

■ [Overview of the second screening]


Judging for the second round (WCSS World Championship Series) will be determined by the total score of the world votes in order to judge from a more global and diverse perspective. From the 3-page tournament vote, 3 works will be selected from the top 1 work for each league, and the final total score will determine the gold, silver, and bronze prizes. Based on [Scoring rules], votes are weighted by voters, and screening is performed according to [Voting regulation].

Voting regulation

- $I \cdots Voting$ and comments can be made by everyone, including exhibitors.
- II ··· You can vote from the [Vote] Google Form.
- III ··· Voting can select 5 works from 100 works.
- $\ensuremath{\mathrm{IV}}\cdots$ Comments, questions, and advice can be made from the [Comment] Google Form.
- $V\cdots$ Please give consideration to the designer when making comments.
- VI... Comments can be made from simple impressions to specific points.
- VII... Double voting and voting guidance If there is an illegal vote, all scores will be abandoned.

- General other than architecture • • • • Perfect score × 0.5 × (5 votes)
- Second screening WCSS contestants should vote and evaluate works other than their own from the Google form below, not the form link at the web work exhibition venue.



■ [Second Round World Voting]

The second round of WCSS will be judged by global voting. Voting is done by architecture students, architects, professors and designers from all over the world, and each person can vote up to 5 votes, weighted by 1 vote. We look forward to your participation. We also welcome your comments and questions. We aim to be a place where opinions and values can be exchanged from various regions. We look forward to your active participation.

■ [Winner selection method]

In the AI preliminary screening, in addition to calculating the new precision scoring, the league that is most suitable for the work will be automatically selected from 10 types of leagues. At the WEB work exhibition venue, works will be displayed by league, global voting will be conducted, and the certificate will be selected based on the total number of votes. The exhibited works will be posted in the order of their score in the preliminary screening. The method of award selection for each league is as shown in the diagram below.

The award results will be published on the website and notified by email. Certificates will be sent by international mail from November 1st. Due to the impact of COVID-19, there is a possibility that there will be delays in shipping and areas where the certificate cannot be shipped.
